## Faith goes mobile

**The Pastoral Faith Inspirational Sms Project co-sponsored by NEGST and Mobile Planet**

Starting January 1<sup>st</sup> 2007, Nairobi Evangelical Graduate School of Theology (NEGST), Mobile Planet and partnering churches are coming together in an inspirational faith building project aimed at connecting congregations to their pastors through daily inspirational messages using the SMS technology. The goal is to connect you as a member of the congregation to your pastor for daily spiritually up lifting messages.

### How it works

Every morning, you will access your pastor's message by simply typing the name of your church followed by the word *ON* for example *ICC ON*. This will enable you access your pastor's daily teachings at only Kshs.10/ per SMS. Whenever you want to switch off the message(s), you will simply type '*ICC OFF*'. This is only valid for participating churches. Remember, you have to use the name of your church or a church you would like to get messages from to access this service.



### Benefits of the project

**Spiritual:** You will be able to connect with your pastor wherever you are. It also offers your pastor a chance to interact with the congregation on daily basis.

**Financial:** The funds received will be used for your Church's ministry and development.

**Educational:** Funds received will be used to offer scholarships to many African Christian Scholars at NEGST.
